## The Queensland Planning Provisions (QPP) version 3.1

## **Proposed changes to QPP version 3.0**

The QPP comprises two modules that contain mandatory and optional components:

- 1. Module A is the template that each local government must adopt for its planning scheme under the Sustainable Planning Act 2009 (the Act).
- 2. Module B instructs and provides guidance about the drafting of all elements of the planning scheme and identifies where optional information may be included by a local government.

The following describes the proposed amendments.
